# I. CHAPTER 102 AND 105 PA DEP DELEGATION AGREEMENTS ON-SITE INSPECTIONS/COMPLAINT HANDLING

- 1. One onsite inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Alpha Recycling/ Gilroy Northeast (Stroudsburg Borough) Work commenced onsite without holding pre-construction meeting. Installation of PCSM BMP's occurring not in accordance with approved plans. E&S BMP's not adequately installed/ maintained. Site is currently in violation. IR 2 sent with Notice of Violation.
- 2. One onsite inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Fehrenbacher Pond Dredging (Ross) Dredging and maintenance of ponds occurring without implementation of E&S BMP's and without development of E&S Plan. Chapter 105 permits/ waivers not obtained. Chapter 102 IR 1 and Chapter 105 IR 1 sent.
- 3. One onsite inspection,  $\underline{\text{Complaint}}$ , Fielder SR 209 Property (Hamilton) No E&S BMP's implemented and no E&S Plan onsite. IR 6 sent.
- 4. One onsite inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Monroe Lakes- 6257 East Lakeshore Drive (Middle Smithfield) Fill imported to site without implementation of E&S BMP's. Site is currently in violation. IR 1 sent with Notice of Violation.
- 5. One onsite inspection, Follow-up, Monroe Lakes 2613 Beanpole Road/ Elohim Excavation (Middle Smithfield) No E&S BMP's implemented and E&S Plan not developed as previously requested. PA DEP Field Order not followed. Site continues to be in violation. IR 3 sent with Notice of Violation.
- 6. One onsite inspection, Routine, RPM Auto Park/ E.F Possinger and CFI Design (Hamilton) PCSM BMP's not adequately maintained. E&S BMP's not adequately removed as previously requested. IR 30 sent.
- 7. One onsite inspection, Follow-up, Walsh Stream Encroachment (Ross) Channel block removed and area adequately restored. Voluntary Restoration Agreement Follow-up letter sent.
- 8. One onsite inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Spruce Hill Farms Yard Regrading and Wetland Fill (Barrett) Fill imported to site and placed within uplands and potential onsite wetlands without implementation of E&S BMP's and without Chapter 105 permitting. Site is currently in violation. Chapter 102 IR 1 sent with Notice of Violation and Chapter 105 IR 1 sent
- 9. One onsite inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Magnolia Streamside Resort (Barrett) Parking lot being installed. E&S BMP's implemented but requires maintenance and modification. Site is currently in violation. IR 2 sent with Compliance Notice.
- 10. One onsite inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Buck Hill Falls Preserve Drive (Barrett) Construction of residential dwelling occurring without implementation of E&S BMP's. Site is currently in violation. IR 1 sent with Compliance Notice.
- 11. One onsite inspection, Follow-up, Summit Road Gallerie Stream Encroachment and Wetland Fill (Pocono) E&S BMP's implemented but not adequately installed. Stream encroachment addressed but wetland fill removal not completed as outlined in Voluntary Restoration Agreement. Chapter 102 IR 2 and Chapter 105 IR 2 sent.
- 12. One onsite inspection,  $\underline{\text{Complaint}}$ , LTS Homes Brodheadsville Sites/ LTS Homes (Chestnuthill) Construction of two lots currently occurring with E&S deficiencies. IR to be sent.
- 13. One on-site inspection, Routine, Dollar General #19872 East Stroudsburg (Middle Smithfield) Contractors grading area for future building. Site currently in compliance.
- 14. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, 152 Farrier Lane (Eldred) Site has determined to not be a CAO. Manure management plan reviewed. Ag IR sent.
- 15. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, 5401 Shelbrooke Dr. In-ground Pool (Stroud) Site graded for future in ground pool. No E&S BMPs in place. IR 1 sent.
- 16. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Neola Valley Farms LLC. (Jackson) Fill placed on west side of stream close to floodway with no E&S BMPs. Stockpiles of mulch and soil materials located adjacent to wetland. IR 2 sent.

- 17. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Gotta Go Potties/Septic Service (Coolbaugh/Mt. Pocono) Wetland determination with Army Corps of Engineers. Filled in area determined not to be wetland. Owner stated future project scope may exceed 1 acre. IR 2 sent.
- 18. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Lot 34 Shafer Drive (Chestnuthill) Fill brought to site. Site graded to improve lot for sale. Inadequate BMPs in place. IR 1 sent.
- 19. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Dragomir Site Development (Tunkhannock) Met Army Corps of Engineers and DEP staff on site for wetland determination. No IR sent.
- 20. One on-site inspection, Routine, Middle Smithfield Materials/Earth Efficient (Middle Smithfield) Swale on West side of fill pile being encroached on by fill. IR 4 sent.
- 21. Two on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Swiftwater Dam Repairs/NSC (Paradise) Stockpile along spillway not protected. Filter bag for spillway excavation located in pipe outlet channel without compost sock protection. IR 4 sent with Compliance Notice. Follow up reveals filter bag has been relocated and properly installed. Stockpile has been seeded and mulched. IR 5 sent.
