COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE - 4 Year Seedling 10" - 22"

One of the finest and most popular trees for ornamental and Christmas tree use. Short needles, some trees turn the characteristic blue color. Grows in normal soil conditions and will tolerate full sun.

EASTERN WHITE PINE - 3 Year Seedling 8" - 16"

A majestic evergreen beauty when planted as a single specimen tree, this very hardy pine grows stately and gracefully tall. Needles are soft and bluish-green in color. With adequate moisture, growth can be 12" to 18" per year. Ideal specimen planting, shade, windbreaks and appealing Christmas tree. Deer do not prefer white pines.

CONCOLOR FIR - 3 Year Seedling 9" - 18"

One of the most beautiful pyramidal coniferous ornamentals. This evergreen has flat, varying soft green to deep blue needles. A very hardy tree growing in a variety of well-drained soils, standing dryness and high temperatures better than other firs. Rapid grower after becoming established. Makes a handsome ornamental specimen, and decorative Christmas tree.

NORWAY SPRUCE - 3 Year Seedling 8" - 16"

This graceful pyramidal has sharp, shiny, dark green needles. An extremely hardy tree that is successful under most soil conditions. Makes a charming Christmas tree, an appealing ornamental specimen, or a protective windbreak.

SUGAR MAPLE - 2 Year Seedling 3" - 6"

An attractive maple that produces shade through dense green foliage. Mature trees produce sap that can be made into delicious maple syrup.

TULIP POPLAR - 2 Year Seedling 15" - 30"

A fast growing tree with good timber volume. Has greenish-yellow flowers in spring and large tulip shaped leaves.

WHITE DOGWOOD - 2 Year Seedling 10" - 20"

A very popular flowering tree that is covered with white-petaled flowers in spring. Also provides red berries in fall, utilized by a wide variety of wildlife.

RED BUD - 2 Year Seedling 12" - 29"

A small flat-topped tree, producing pink blossoms in early spring. Foliage is large and heart shaped. Does well in a protected location.
