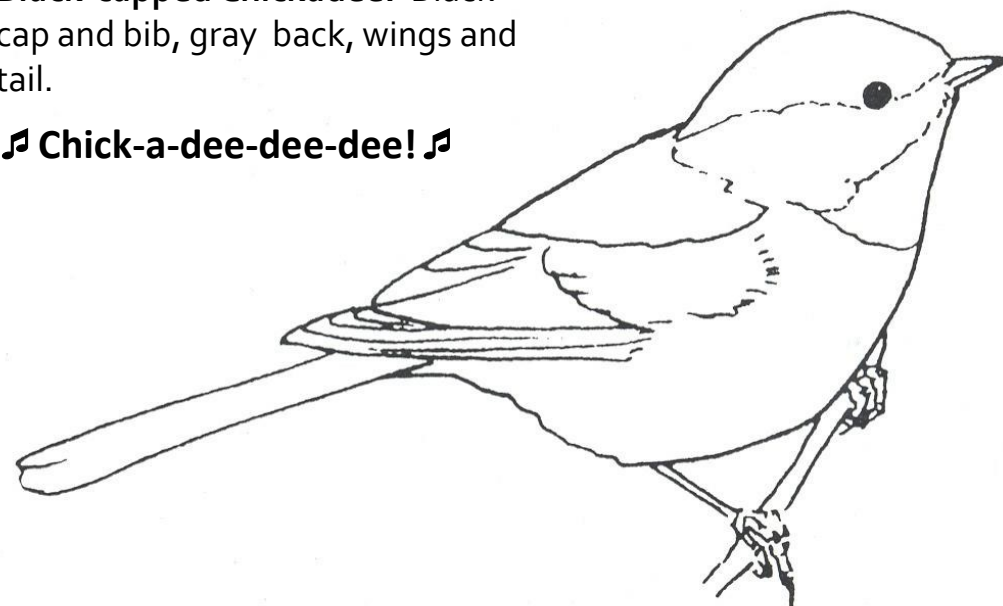


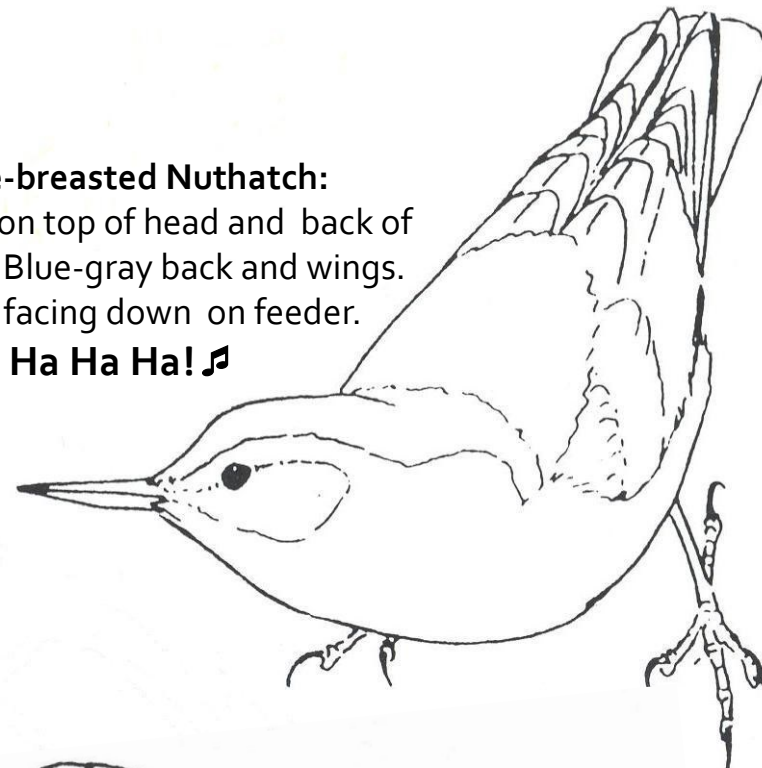
Black-capped Chickadee: Black cap and bib, gray back, wings and tail.

♪ Chick-a-dee-dee-dee! ♪



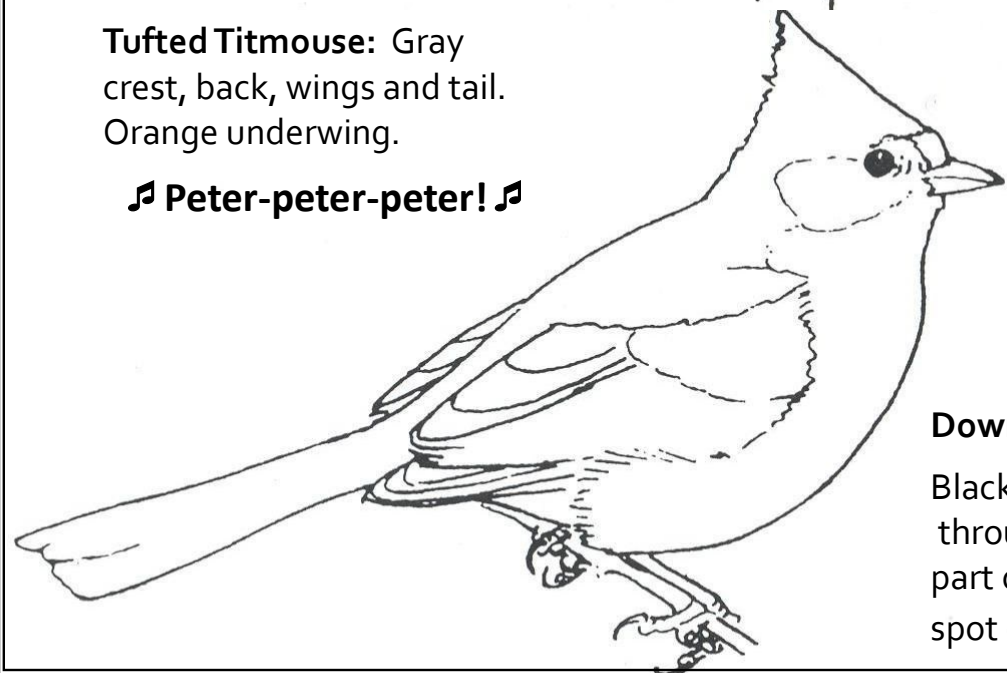
White-breasted Nuthatch: Black on top of head and back of neck. Blue-gray back and wings. Often facing down on feeder.

♪ Ha Ha Ha Ha! ♪



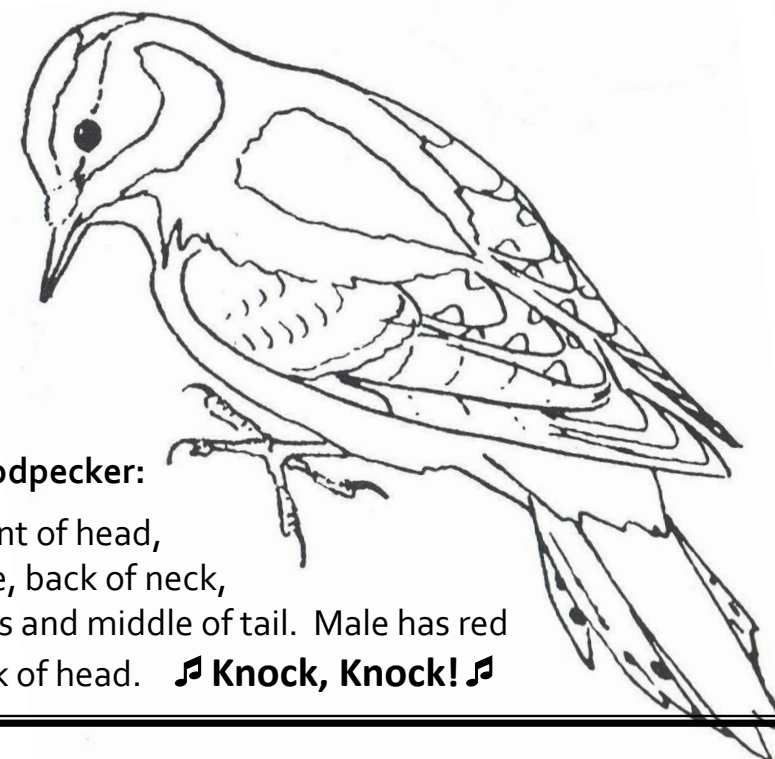
Tufted Titmouse: Gray crest, back, wings and tail. Orange underwing.

Black on front of head, through eye, back of neck, part of wings and middle of tail. Male has red spot on back of head. ♪ Knock, Knock! ♪



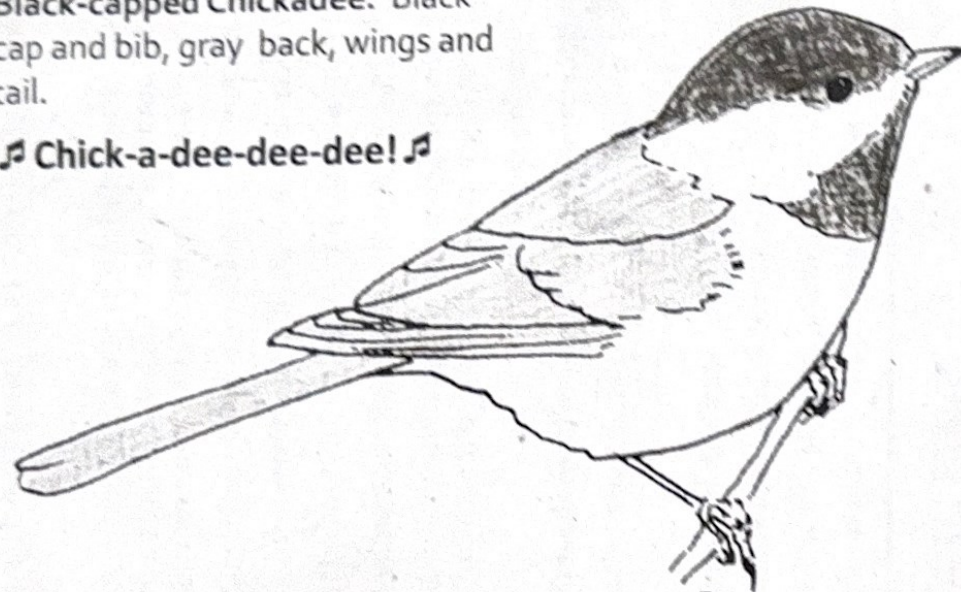

Field Marks of Common Birds

A field mark is an outstanding feature of a bird that helps you to identify the species. Once you know the common field marks, you can recognize the bird, even if you only get a glimpse.

Black-capped Chickadee: Black cap and bib, gray back, wings and tail.

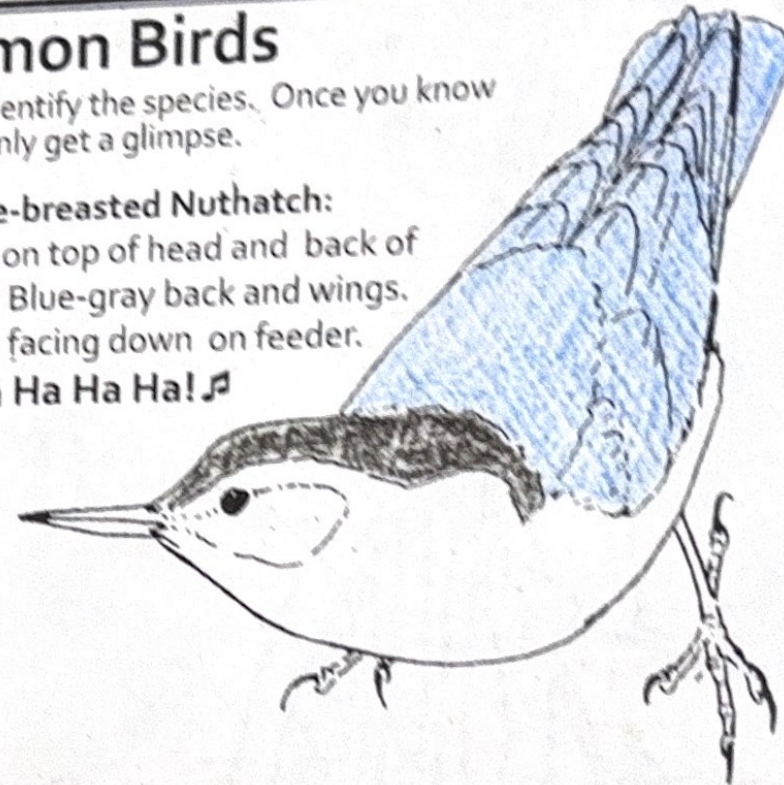

White-breasted Nuthatch:

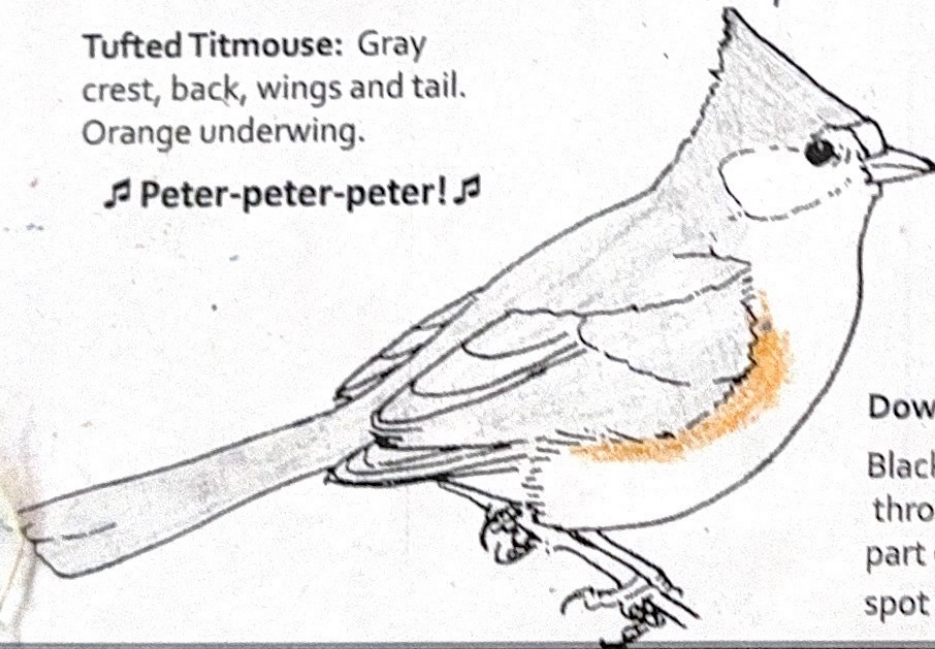
Black on top of head and back of neck. Blue-gray back and wings. Often facing down on feeder.
