

Dirt & Gravel/Low Volume Road Program Eligible Entities-Monroe County

Eligibility for DGLVR grant funding is based on the municipality having a current ESM trained employee or official overseeing the project. This two-day training certification is good for 5 years from the date of training. A current list of ESM training participants and training dates is attached. If you are on the fifth year following your certification date, this is the last year your municipality is eligible to apply for a grant unless you have someone attend training.

ESM Training is recommended for all employees involved in road maintenance, as well as any administrators who oversee grant applications and billing related to DGLVR projects.
