I. <u>CHAPTER 102 AND 105 PA DEP DELEGATION AGREEMENTS</u> ON-SITE INSPECTIONS/COMPLAINT HANDLING

1. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Fehrenbacher Pond Dredging (Ross) - Dredging work being performed as maintenance. Temporary stabilization performed to disturbed areas and E&S BMP's implemented. Site is currently in compliance. Chapter 102 IR 2 and Chapter 105 IR 2 sent.

2. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Hamlen ATV Track and Wetland Fill (Hamilton) - Fill placed within onsite wetlands without obtaining Chapter 105 permit coverage. Chapter 105 IR 1 and Voluntary Restoration Agreement Letter sent.

3. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Monroe Lakes 2613 Beanpole Road/ Elohim (Middle Smithfield) - E&S plan not developed/ submitted as requested. E&S BMP's not implemented and DEP Field Order not being followed. Site remains in violation. IR 4 sent with Notice of Violation.

4. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Monroe Lakes 6257 East Lakeshore Drive (Middle Smithfield) - E&S BMP's partially implemented onsite. Stabilization not performed. Fill placed within lake and shoreline. Site is currently in violation. Chapter 102 IR 2 sent with Compliance Notice and Chapter 105 IR 1 sent.

5. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Owens Yard Work- Mountain Road (Jackson) -Brush stockpiled near onsite wetlands/ stream. Site is currently in compliance. IR 1 sent.

6. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, PCP 6101 Boardwalk Drive (Coolbaugh) -Unauthorized fill within Lake Carobeth removed. Site is currently in compliance. Chapter 105 Voluntary Restoration Agreement sent.

7. One on-site inspection, Routine, PennDOT SR 611 Scot Run to Swiftwater/ Leeward and UGI (Pocono) - Minor E&S BMP implementation needed. Project near complete. IR 20 sent.

8. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Twin Hills Williamson Kopelson Lot/ RGB (Stroud) - Stabilization performed. Updated E&S Plan needed. IR 2 sent.

9. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, VanLauren Properties- Split Creek Preserve/Domenico (Chestnuthill) - CFS installed at new cottage. Compliance meeting scheduled. IR 2 sent.

10. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Stillwater Lake Estates-Laurel and Pine Tree Rds (Tobyhanna) - Downstream end of pipe is plugged. POA plans to restore flow and provide stable conveyance along Laurel Rd. E&S plan required. IR 1 sent.

One on-site inspection, Routine, Schoolhouse Estates/DE&S (Price) - UG utilities have been installed, several swales not restored after excavation. IR 19 sent. 20. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Feola Driveway Fill/Benami (Smithfield) -Area of fill is seeded and mulched. IR 2 sent. 21. One on-site inspection, Routine, Middle Smithfield Library/NSC (Middle Smithfield) - Rain garden areas recently mowed, other areas are stabilized. IR 3 sent. 22. One on-site inspection, Technical Assistance, Seneca Rd. Properties (Mt. Pocono) - Spring seep leading to stream channel through several front yards. Discussed 102 and 105 information with owners wanting to pipe the stream through their properties. 23. Two on-site inspections, Complaint, Pham Lot-Arrowhead Lake (Tobyhanna) -Lakefront cleared with gravel installed along lakeshore without Chapter 105 authorization. Additional stone piles on site. Discussed 105 requirements with owner, who agreed to remove stone along lake. Follow-up reveals additional stone fill added along lakeshore. 105 IR sent. Owner agreed to restore. 24. One on-site inspection, Technical Assistance, Unangst Lot- Robinhood Lakes (Polk) - Met with owner regarding stormwater flow across property and stable management. 25. One on-site inspection, Technical Assistance, PennDOT Mill Pond Road Bridge Stream Restoration/Minichi (Polk) - Met with contractor and PFBC biologist regarding installation of mud sills and cross vanes, removal of gravel bar and restoring stream to one channel following pier removal. 26. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, 330 Stillwater Dr.- Stillwater Estates (Coolbaugh) - Restoration conducted prior year remains, no additional fill or structures in regulated waters. 27. One on-site inspection, Technical Assistance, 334 Stillwater Dr.- Stillwater Estates (Coolbaugh) - Owner with drainage course along and across property wants to place fill along lakeshore. Provided permit information and technical guidance. 28. One on-site inspection, Technical Assistance, Peter's Lot and Animal Sanctuary (Shooting Range and Campsite) (Tobyhanna) - Wetland area across front of parcel will require crossing to access upland area of site. Provided 102 and 105 permit information along with technical information for wetland crossing installations. 29. One on-site inspection, Routine, Sanofi Seed Lab and Waste Building/A. Scott (Pocono) - Compost sock not maintained at utility trench, area not stabilized. Seed lab prepared for seed. IR 1 sent. 30. One on-site inspection, Routine, Swiftwater Dam/NSC (Paradise) - Additional BMPs installed at stockpile. Vegetation germinating. IR 6 sent. 31. One on-site inspection, Complaint, Selvi Lot- Bisbing Rd. (Paradise) - Half acre disturbed for pole barn. Owner installing filter fence. No E&S plan. IR 1 sent. 32. One on-site inspection, Technical Assistance, Blake Lot- Arrowhead Lake (Tobyhanna) - Owner has artesian well discharging to lake, concerns about erosion and shoreline bank erosion from stormwater. Provided erosion and stormwater control information. 33. One on-site inspection, Complaint, Ownana Rd Lot-Arrowhead Lake (Coolbaugh) -Topsoil spread on wetland area without Chapter 105 authorization. 105 IR sent. Corps to coordinate restoration. 34. One on-site inspection, Routine, Northridge Estates Sections 11-16/P&M (Pocono) - Infiltration basins installed on Holly Ct. sites. IR 61 sent.

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35. One on-site inspection, Routine, MPMA WWTP Upgrade and Spray Field/Pioneer (Mt. Pocono/Paradise) - Areas around tanks and roads are seeded, MPMA is watering regularly. IR 6 sent, NOT to be submitted. 36. No $\overline{E\&S}$ plan on site. Stockpiles of soil located in wetland area. 102 and 105 IR 1 and Restoration agreement sent. 40. One on-site inspection, Complaint, Abrams Stockpile (Hamilton) - Lawn area where heavy equipment was placed was stabilized with straw and grass seed. Area next to existing building graded for additional parking. Permit obtained for future barn construction. No E&S plan on site. IR 1 sent. 41. One on-site inspection, Complaint, Laurel Lake Rd. (Pocono) -Underground utility repairs occurred. Stabilization to be applied. No inspection report sent. 42. One on-site inspection, Complaint, Blue Capstone LLC. Properties (Tobyhanna) - 2 adjacent properties under active construction. Earth disturbance exceeds 1 acre without obtaining an NPDES permit. Site is currently in violation.
