I. CHAPTER 102 AND 105 PA DEP DELEGATION AGREEMENTS ON-SITE INSPECTIONS/COMPLAINT HANDLING

- 1. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Dependent Dr. Fill site (Middle Smithfield) Approximately 15-25 loads of fill were delivered and graded on site. Site lacked perimeter control E&S BMPs, E&S plan and Stabilization. IR 1 sent.
- 2. One on-site inspection, Follow up, Sugar Hollow Rd. Somogyi Fill Site, (Chestnuthill) Approximately 0.6 acres of the site was filled and graded with crushed concrete. Minor Interim stabilization required. E&S plan on site and silt fence in place. IR 2 sent.
- 3. Two on-site inspections, Follow up, Holiday Dr. Palacios Wetland Fill, (Coolbaugh) Landscaping materials stockpiled in floodway and potential wetlands. Chapter 105 IR 2 & 3 sent.
- 4. One on-site inspection, Follow up, Evergreen Estates Marroccoli Fill site, (Middle Smithfield) E&S plan was provided to MCCD but was not followed. Site recently graded to plan but lacked perimeter control E&S BMPs and Stabilization. Sediment deposition noted in wetland. IR 2 sent with NOV.
- 5. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, 505 Coolbaugh Rd Fill Site, (Middle Smithfield) Construction of an in ground pool. Site lacked perimeter control E&S BMPs, E&S plan, and stabilization. IR 1 Sent.
- 6. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Route 115 Access Rd Possinger, (Ross) An access road, staging area, and turn around were graded into the Hill side to access a land locked parcel. No E&S BMPs in place at the time of inspection. Owner immediately followed up with photos of the site stabilized. IR 1 Sent.
- 7. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, PennDOT Exit 308, (East Stroudsburg) Tracking on onramp. Unauthorized access being used without rock construction entrance. Additional contractor co-permittee agreements required and E&S plan mod. IR 3 sent with Compliance Notice.
- 8. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Scotrun Estates Deerfield Way Driveway, (Pocono) Owner was reconstructing driveway, roadside swale, and filling around home. Site lacked perimeter control E&S BMPs and Stabilization. IR 1 sent.
- 9. One on-site inspection, Final, Godfrey's Ridge Subdivision/ RGB Homes (Stroud Township and Stroudsburg Borough) All PCSM BMP's installed, permanent stabilization obtained and temporary E&S BMP's removed. Site is currently in compliance. IR 13 sent with Notice of Termination approval.
- 10. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, I80-115, C-1 Site/ Papillon & Moyer (Tunkhannock) Contactor initiated clearing operations prior to obtaining NPDES Permit. Site is currently in violation. IR 1 sent with Notice of Violation.

- 11. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Kerrick Dwelling- 190 Kerrick Road (Tobyhanna) E&S Plan onsite with BMP implementation. IR 3 sent.
- 12. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, LTS Homes 2307 Clearview Avenue Dwelling (Stroud) Onsite E&S Plan requires modification. Additional E&S BMP implementation needed. IR 1 sent.
- 13. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, <u>Metzgar</u> Road Wetland Crossing (Stroud) Wetlands crossed to perform septic testing on two vacant lots without obtaining Chapter 105 permit. Stabilization from testing needed. Chapter 102 IR 1 and Chapter 105 IR 1 sent.
- 14. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Pensyl Creek Road- Appenzell Creek (Hamilton) Inspection performed to document movement of Appenzell Creek following 2020 tropical storms. No IR sent.
- 15. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Pocono Plaza/ Kobalt Construction (East Stroudsburg Borough) PCSM deficiencies still exist. Gully erosion sill occurring in multiple locations. Site is currently in violation. IR 7 sent with Compliance Notice.
- 16. One on-site inspection, Routine, Sand Spring Run Streambank Stabilization/Rutledge (Jackson) Minor stabilization needed, and spring seep erosion gullies need to be monitored. IR 4 sent.
- 17. One on-site inspection, Routine, Suburban Realty/ Colombo Enterprises (Stroud) E&S BMP's and stabilization adequately performed. Discharge point associated with project inconsistent with what was provided on NPDES application. IR 2 sent.
- 18. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Cox Building Addition and Drainage (Stroud) Stabilization applied to disturbed areas. E&S BMP's needed below filled area. IR 3 sent.
- 19. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Euro Style Homes Building Expansion (Smithfield) Perimeter control E&S BMP's installed. Additional stabilization needed. IR 2 sent.
- 20. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Leisure Lands 212 Chickadee Way (Middle Smithfield) Additional stabilization and E&S BMP installation needed. Status pending DEP Solid Waste. IR 3 sent.
- 21. One on-site inspection, Routine, Dollar General Cresco/ MSG (Barrett)-Emergency spillway and basin outlet structure deficient. Site is stabilized. IR3 sent.
- 22. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Northridge- Grossi Lots/ R.F. Excavating (Pocono/ Jackson) Erosion control measures installed on two lots under construction. NPDES permit pending, CAP. IR4 sent. Permit application due February 17.
- 23. One on-site inspection, Routine, Koby's Creekside Grill/ Empire (Pocono) New leasee placing rock along the parking lot on flood prone property adjacent to Pocono Creek. Advised the contractor of Chapter 105

permit requirements and discussed tree cutting with the leasee and the contractor as the new owner has an NPDES permit application for the adjacent property and the property is in Pocono Creek buffer.

- 24. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Berolo Lot SR 447/ JF Property Services (Barrett) Approximately 2 acres cleared for lot development. No E&S plan developed. Wetlands present on site. IR1 sent.
- 25. One on-site inspection, Final, ESU Creekview Park Turf Fields/ ESU (Stroud) BMPs installed and maintained. IR4 sent with NOT acknowledgment.
- 26. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Cortazzo Lot/ Image Landscaping (Jackson) owner filling section of driveway to ease grade for better winter access. Also filling for parking area within 75' of stream. NO E&S plan. NO BMPs. IR1 sent.
