I. CHAPTER 102 AND 105 PA DEP DELEGATION AGREEMENTS ON-SITE INSPECTIONS/COMPLAINT HANDLING

- 1. Two on-site inspections- <u>Complaint</u>- Dowd Lot- Effort Neola Rd/Whispering Farms (Jackson)- Landscaping around dwelling and garage. No BMPs. No E&S Plan. IR1 sent. Follow-up revealed site is seeded and mulched. IR 2 sent.
- 2. Two on-site inspections- $\underline{\text{Complaint}}$ Koons Wetland Fill (Chestnuthill)- Approximately 500 sq. feet of wetland fill in Frog Hollow. 105 IR sent. Met with the owner who agreed to restore. Restoration agreement sent.
- 3. One on-site inspection- Routine- Brenda Wells Demo/Nansteele (Hamilton) House demolition completed and new basement prepped for footers. Filter fence not extended to capture disturbed area. IR1 sent.
- 4. One on-site inspection- <u>Complaint</u>- Schaller Pole Barn/Pocono Pole Builders (Hamilton) Steep bank cuts behind and around building. Provided stabilization information to owner. IR1 sent.
- 5. One on-site inspection- <u>Complaint</u>- Capasso Land Development/ Ray Capasso (Hamilton/Chestnuthill) Owner clearing trees and brush along 209. No NPDES permit for Earth Disturbance over 1 acre. No stabilization or controls implemented. IR3 sent with NOV.
- 6. One on-site inspection- Routine- Bernard Wetland Fill (Hamilton) Fill in wetland downslope of new barn expansion. Owner agreed to remove. 105 IR and restoration agreement sent.
- 7. Two on-site inspections- <u>Complaint</u>- Altemose Pond Maintenance (Chestnuthill) Spoil material from pond dredging deposited in floodway. 105 IR sent. Owner agreed to restore. Restoration completed and stabilized.
- 8. Two on-site inspections- $\underline{\text{Complaint}}$ Price Channel Dredging/Uncle Bob (Chestnuthill) Approximately 150' of headwater channel dredged. 105 IR sent. Owner agreed to restore.
- 9. One on-site inspection- <u>Complaint</u>- Benami Fill Site with PFBC (Smithfield) Pond outlet and fill material along berm not stabilized. Fill material from 2018 not stabilized. PFBC documented sediment pollution. IR4 sent with NOV. 105 IR sent. Site to be referred to DEP.
- 10. One on-site inspection- <u>Complaint- Ndoci Wetland Encroachments</u> (Middle Smithfield Township) Trench dug through wetland/small pond constructed in wetland without permit. Site to be referred for restoration/permit options. 105 IR sent.
- 11. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Route 196 LLC. Sewer Line (Coolbaugh) A trench was excavated to replace a sewer line and fill was piled next to the trench. No E&S plan or BMPs. Owner agreed to stop work and retore. IR 1 sent.
- 12. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Pocono Mountains Corporate Center North Warehouse Schlouch (Mount Pocono) Roads were cleared and partially grubbed, test pits dug preemptive to anticipated public hearing. NPDES Permit is currently under review. No E&S controls or plan. NOV sent with IR 1.
- 13. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, 387 Coolbaugh Rd. Fill Site (Middle Smithfield) Fill brought by NJ trucks and place behind the residence to create a yard area. Approximately 25 truckloads of fill. No FP001 form or E&S plan were

available at the time of inspection. To be referred to DEP. Site lacked ${\tt E\&S}$ BMPs. IR 1 sent.

- 14. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>/routine, Clarius Park I-380 Warehouse / Blue Rock & Schlouch (Mount Pocono) Complaints of dust. MCCD recommended that dust be monitored and controlled by watering or the use of temporary or permanent stabilization. Site had minor E&S deficiencies. A minor amendment is currently under review. IR 2 sent.
- 15. One on-site inspection, Follow up, The Lakeside Parking lot Fill Site (Hamilton) A propane tank was buried at the edge of the parking lot and stabilized with straw mulch and grass seed. Additional bmp maintenance was required. IR 2 sent.
- 16. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Willie Mae's Place Encroachment (Chestnuthill) An area for a garden and parking area were created within the floodway of the Pohopoco Creek without Chapter 105 Authorization. 105 IR 1 Sent.
- 17. One on-site inspection, Complaint, Ross Rd. Sovoia Clearing and encroachment. (Ross) Approximately 0.5 Acres of the site along Ross Rd. have were cleared and grubbed. Work was conducted within the floodway of an UNT Buckwha Creek. No E&S control BMPs on site at the time of inspection. Chapter 105 and 102 IR 1 Sent.
- 18. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Bartell Spoils Site (Tobyhanna) The site was inactive at the time of inspection. E&S perimeter control BMPs were maintained and no work was conducted outside of the LOD. No violations noted. IR 1 sent.
- 19. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, 140 Waczip Ln. Water Tank (Tobyhanna) An underground water tank was installed for a cabin onsite. Some of the site had received stone for stabilization but additional stabilization was still required. No E&S plan. IR 1 sent.
- 20. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Lower Swiftwater Rd Conochan (Paradise) An existing ford crossing was being used to access property and dwelling across the creek. No violations noted at the time of inspection. 105 IR 1 sent.
