## COVID-19 Program Policy

### “Get in Touch With Nature Summer Day Camp”

- Kettle Creek “Get in Touch With Nature Summer Day Camp” activities & programs are designed to comply with current CDC guidance.
- All KEEC staff has been trained on management practices for prevention and dealing with potential on-site cases of illness. Staff is updated as new information is made accessible.
- KCEEC staff will undergo morning health screenings to monitor symptoms.
- All participants will get temperature checks upon arrival. If any participant shows signs of illness they will not be allowed to attend the program.
- All facilities are will be disinfected daily including: classroom spaces, main building, and pavilion. Camp staff will disinfect all common areas and bathrooms at the end of each camp day. Periodic disinfection will occur after group activities in shared spaces as needed.
- A maximum of 20 campers and 2 KCEEC staff will be maintained during all camp activities.
- All campers will be assigned specific bathroom, classroom, lunch and outdoor space separate from other KCEEC staff and program participants.
- Face masks that cover both nose and mouth will be required during all indoor activities and during registration each day.
- Social distancing will be maintained during seated activities, lunch etc. During outside activities it will be maintained as much as possible.
- No off-site field trips will occur.
- Drop-off and pick-up procedures have been modified to allow family members to remain in their vehicles while dropping off campers.
- All equipment used during program activities will be sanitized before and after each use.
- All participants will bring their own lunch, no sharing will be allowed. Everyone will bring their own refillable water bottle. Liquids will be furnished in a sanitized manner.
- If any participant shows signs of illness they will be removed from programs and isolated in a designated area. KCEEC staff will notify family members immediately and work with local health officials to determine best course of action.
