What, When, Why

What Let the NOT Completeness Checklist Be your Guide!

What

- **As-Built Record Plans**
- **Submit for review prior to recordation! – E-mail is OK**
 - Plans should reflect the as-built condition of the PCSM BMPs.
 - Include OCS elevations, BMP top of berm, BMP bottom, and location information, location and elevations of all PCSM BMPs, location / condition of any plan changes through construction, preferably on the original PCSM Plan with new elevations identified in bold or italics. – Keep in mind some of the BMPs will not be able to be seen once they are covered so survey during construction may be necessary.
 - The Plan needs to identify the O&M procedures for all PCSM BMPs (Keep this in mind when setting up your PCSM Plans)
 - The plans need to contain the following information if they are not being recorded as part of a Land Development or Subdivision Plan (including as-built Record Plans)
 - Owner signature – Notarized
 - Tax Code # (s)
 - Township Name (s)
 - Professional's Seal
 - 1 Original Mylar copy needed no larger than 24x36

What

- Legal instrument providing for long term O&M. Sample document available – This gets recorded at the office of the recorder only needs to be submitted when the PCSM Stormwater Management Instrument Filing Notice can not be completed.
- Copy of Recorder of Deeds Receipt
- PCSM Stormwater Management Instrument Filing Notice or the entire package of recorded documents
 - Please note that the PCSM Stormwater Management Instrument Filing Notice does not replace the legal instrument.
- Submission of receipts alone is no longer sufficient.

What to take when you are going to the recorder.

45 day initial recordation

- PCSM Plans (This is best done when the subdivision or land development plans are recorded)
- Executed Instrument for Long Term O&M
- PCSM Instrument Filing Notice

At the Time of NOT

- AS-Built Record Plans
- Amended Executed Instrument for Long Term O&M
- Amended PCSM Instrument Filing Notice
