C. CHAPTER 102 AND 105 PA DEP DELEGATION AGREEMENTS ON-SITE INSPECTIONS/COMPLAINT HANDLING

- 1. One On-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Roman Wetland Fill/Sinai (Smithfield Township) Unauthorized fill in wetland. Material suspect. 105 IR sent. Referred to solid waste for sampling.
- 2. Two On-site inspections, Complaint/Technical Assistance, Saylor's Lake Stormwater Improvements (Hamilton Township) Inlet box installed along access road to lake. Met with membership and maintenance coordinators to assess their goals and any permit requirements. Provided information on Stormwater treatment and drainage area considerations for managing runoff into the lake. IR 1 sent.
- 3. Two On-site inspections, <u>Complaint</u>, SR447 Donaldson Fill Site/Sinai (Barrett Township) Approximately half acre fill site, no BMPs. Site within 100 feet of headwater stream. Tracking on SR 447. CN sent with IR 1. Suspect fill referred to DEP solid waste.
- 4. One On-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Stroudsburg Pocono Airpark/Nauman (Smithfield Township) Approximately 4 acres disturbed without NPDES Permit. Fill and utilities installed in wetland. NOV sent with IR 2, 105 IR sent.
- 5. One On-site inspection, Technical Assistance, Northridge Spruce Drive Repairs/Kobalt (Jackson Township) Met with contractor on placement of outfall and provided clarification on water management. Contractor to complete work the following week.
- 6. One On-site inspection, Technical Assistance, Karaman Lot (Polk Township) Owner concerned about water on property. Road crossing at creek is a stone French drain. No signs of erosion. Township will clean French drain of debris.
- 7. One On-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Pleasant View Lake Lot 3031 (Polk Township) Owner replacing driveway pipe along lot frontage. Owner preparing to stabilize. IR 1 sent.
- 8. One On-site inspection, Routine, Pleasant View Lake Lot 3057 (Polk Township) Unauthorized fill placed in wetland. 105 IR sent. Owner to remove fill. MCCD to reinspect.
- 9. One On-site inspection, Meeting, Nyack 145 Manor Drive/Sinai (Smithfield Township) Met with DEP solid waste, ACOE and owner to set path to compliance addressing waste, E&S and wetland fill. Owner to have site fill characterized, then waste will review and determine remediation requirements. DEP will coordinate wetland fill removal with Corps of Engineers upon determination of fill material contents.

- 10. One On-site inspection, Final, Penn Regional Business Center III/Pocono Health System (Smithfield Township) Site is completed with PCSM BMPs installed. Notice of Termination approved with IR 16.
- 11. One On-site inspection, Routine, Schoolhouse Estates/Classic Quality (Price Township) Underground utilities being installed. BMPs functional. IR 10 sent.
- 12. One On-site inspection, Routine, PennDOT Exit 310 Bridge Replacements/HRI (Smithfield Township and Delaware Water Gap Borough) Basins being converted to Stormwater. Grading adjustments made to get water to correct inlets. IR 5 sent.
- 13. One On-site inspection, Routine, The Woods subdivision/Parisi (Polk Township) Several lots under construction without BMPs in place. Phase II of road work is underway. IR 23 sent.
- 14. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Bamboo Lane Tire Rutting (Stroud Township) Tire ruts from heavy equipment in yard IR1 Sent.
- 15. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Flanagan Wetland Fill (Polk Township) Unauthorized fill in wetland. IR1 and Voluntary Restoration Letter sent.
- 16. Two on-site inspections, Complaint, 862 Greenview Drive/ Earth Efficient Greenview (Hamilton) BMP's require maintenance onsite. Drainage areas not adequately maintained to the installed sediment traps. MCCD IR 30 sent. Follow-up: Additional BMP's implemented and existing BMP's maintained. MCCD discussed implementation of additional BMP's to maintain adequate drainage areas onsite. IR 31 sent.
- 17. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, New Ventures Park Lot 100/110- Lot 110 Construction/ Muschlitz, ARCO, Giroux (Tobyhanna) Stormwater conveyance to E&S BMP's not maintained resulting in sediment laden stormwater discharge to the receiving wetlands and stream. Site is currently in violation. IR 57 sent with Notice of Violation.
- 18. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, Weiss- 205 Fenner Ave. Encroachment (Hamilton) Fill of streambed consistency placed within onsite wetland and within the floodway to an UNT to McMichaels Creek without obtaining permit coverage. Chapter 102 IR 1 and Chapter 105 IR 1 sent.
- 19. One on-site inspection, Routine, Bartell Soil Site/ EarthEfficeint Bartell (Tobyhanna) Inadequate permanent stabilization performed to an onsite swale. Sediment trap installed in accordance with approved plans. IR 20 sent.
- 20. One on-site inspection, <u>Complaint</u>, <u>Emerald Lakes 1211 Sioux Court Wetland Fill/ Classic Quality Homes (Tobyhanna) Existing permit to construct driveway (currently in process of obtaining). Potential fill within wetlands for construction of dwelling. Additional stabilization and E&S BMP maintenance needed. Chapter 102 IR 1 and Chapter 105 IR 1 sent.</u>
- 21. One on-site inspection, Final, Dollar General Pocono Pines/ E.F. Possinger (Tobyhanna) Site stabilized and Notice of Termination(NOT) to be approved. Site is currently in compliance. IR 8 to be sent with NOT acknowledgement.
- 22. One on-site inspection, Routine, Mount Airy 2017 Expansion/ Leeward and T.N Ward (Paradise) Perimeter control E&S BMP's removed prior to establishment of permanent stabilization. Additional stone removal needed onsite. IR 11 sent.
- 23. One on-site inspection, Follow-up, Pocono Organics (Tunkhannock) NPDES permit has not yet been issued and is currently under review.

Contractor constructing garage/ dwelling within NPDES permit boundary. No E&S plan onsite, and E&S BMP's had not been implemented. Applicant confirmed that lease agreement/project excludes garage/ dwelling. NPDES boundary revisions to be reviewed. IR 2 to be sent.
